

Year 6PSHCE Overview

Autumn 1- Looking After Our Environment 2

In this unit the year 6 children re-visit what a democracy is. They look at their responsibilities in helping to look after our environment and ways that they can do that.

Autumn 2- Managing Risks

The children are given the opportunity to decide what a risk is and how they can be encouraged to take risks by their peers. They look at the side effects of drugs, smoking and alcohol and why people feel the need to try some of these things. They also discuss ways to help them to keep safe in their local area.

Spring - Money

This term the children look at what a job is. They are given the opportunity to work in small groups to come up with a product that they could make and sell to make money. As the children work through their project the children will decide on their roles in the team in order for their project to run smoothly. Towards the end of the project the children discuss whether their project went well and what it means to be rich or poor.

Summer 1- Where We Belong

The children explore what it means to be British and what ethnic differences exist in our country. They look at different types of relationships that they may have with different people. They then go on to look at stereotyping and the importance of not judging a book by its cover.

Summer 2- Moving On

The year 6s end the year by looking at how to deal with conflicts in friendships and how you might end a friendship. They discuss that it is easy to offend people especially on social media, when you can't see people's facial expressions or hear their tone of voice.
